

Numbers and Nouns

If you read through the “Sources and Further Readings” at the end of this sheet, you will find that not all the examples in the books produce the same exact patterns among themselves on this topic. We will have to accept that there are some slight variations and not be too worried about it.

There are, however, several rules to which we must adhere:

- **aon** causes lenition, except d & t
- **dhà** causes lenition, including d & t, and is **dà** before nouns; some people use the dative form - (where feminine nouns slenderize), or some words use this form as a holdover from the past; adjectives directly modifying nouns after **dà** lenite too, regardless of the noun’s gender
- **trì** to **naoi** take the plural form, except when they don’t (e.g. bliadhna, latha, oidhche, sgillinn)
- nouns go between number-words when the number is a compound, except in mathematical calculations where number phrases are not split
- **deug** lenites like an adjective (e.g. after feminine nouns), except in the phrase for “11 o’ clock”
- the words for multiples of **10** (e.g. 20, 30, 40, etc.) take singular nouns, except the number 10 itself; the word “**dusan**” (dozen) also takes the singular form.
- The question, “Cò mhead,” (how many) uses the singular form

In books, look for topics like “age”, anything having to do with money, “Cò mhead,” “telling time,” and the like for other examples.

0 neoni - we don’t use zero in this way. We might say, “Chan eil cù agam idir,” (I don’t have a dog at all) or “Tha mi gun chù,” (I am without a dog) or “Tha cù a dhith orm,” (I am lacking a dog).
