Note: When using numbers with two words, if a noun is associated, it goes in the middle. For example:

aon chat deug	11 cats	dà chat dheug	12 cats	trì cait deug	13 cats
ceithir cait deug	14 cats	còig cait deug	15 cats	sia cait deug	16 cats
