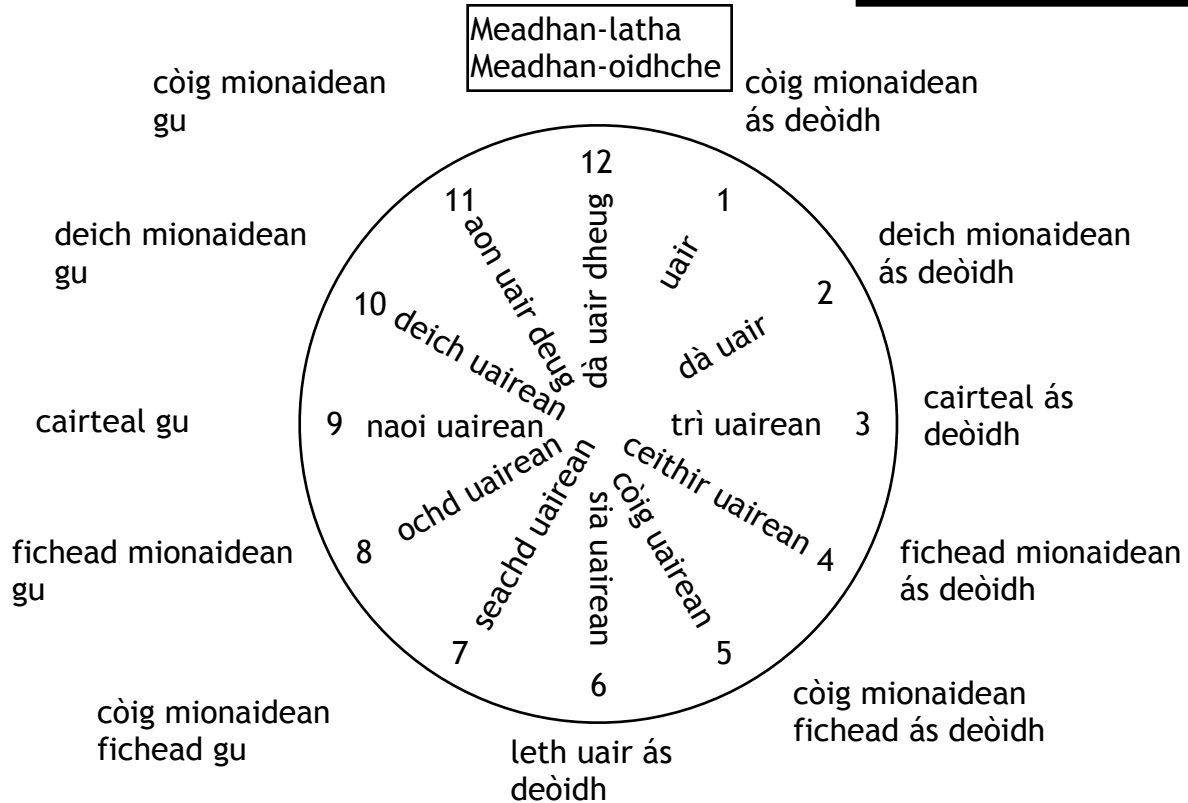


Telling Time

First, the layout of the clock. A few words and phrases:

as deigh \ after
 gu \ to
 cairteal \ quarter
 leth uair \ half
 Meadhan \ middle or mid

Note: you could get more specific than five minute increments in the Highlands, but sheep don't really notice.



Dè an uair a tha e? / What time is it?

To answer “Dè an uair a tha e?” follow the following pattern:

Verb + Subject	Minutes	Hours	Part of Day (Optional)
Tha e	còig mionaidean as deigh	trì uairean	anns an fheasgair.
Tha e	leth uair as deigh	ochd uairean	anns a' mhadainn.
Tha e	cairteal gu	deich uairean.	
Tha e	(leave blank if on the hour)	uair.
